



The 2005 Memorial Exhibit

The 2005 Memorial Exhibit is a traveling memorial honoring the 17 Nevada individuals who were murdered by their intimate partners during 2005. The exhibit includes 17 t-shirts that are red and bear the name and story of a murdered woman. An 18th shirt represents the uncounted women whose deaths were unreported or unacknowledged.

The objective of the 2005 Memorial Exhibit is to raise awareness in our communities about the extent of domestic violence and to help connect people with resources for ending the violence in their lives.

The 2005 Memorial Exhibit is a powerful tool which silently speaks to the hearts of individuals who witness it. The Exhibit should be displayed at locations where the shirts will be treated with respect and honor. Suggestions for locations include: libraries, court houses, law enforcement offices, community colleges, post offices, and hospitals.

When you receive the final Agreement signed both by you and a Nevada Network Against Domestic Violence representative, you will know that your Exhibit dates have been reserved. The 2005 Memorial Exhibit will then be mailed to you by the date specified on the Agreement; or, if you are located in or around the Reno/Sparks area, you may come by the Network office to pick up the Exhibit. Each 2005 Memorial Exhibit Kit will contain all the supplies you'll need to display the 18 t-shirts in a variety of ways: 20 black plastic hangers, 18 suction cups with hooks, 6 portable clothes lines (three t-shirts will fit on each line), 1 regular 50' clothes line, 40 regular clothes pins, a package of 80 count straight pins, and two laminated signs explaining the Exhibit.

You will then be responsible for returning the 2005 Memorial Exhibit and all of the components of the Kit to the Network by the date indicated on the Agreement. You may mail it back to us or drop it off at the Network office.
